# The 2007 Texas State criterium Championships



## Course:

1 mile figure 8 in the Fort Worth Cultural District; described as "The best Crit course in Texas..."  
Road Surfaces include mostly asphalt with one short, straight section brick cobbles.  
Same course as last 3-years.

## Directions to Will Rogers Center:

- The Will Rogers Center is approximately 1 mile west of downtown Fort Worth.
- From Austin: I-35W north to I-30, west on I-30 approximately 1 mile to Montgomery St., north on Montgomery, right (east) on Harley, left (north) on Gendy.
- From Houston: I-45 north to I-30, west to Montgomery St., north on Montgomery, right (east) on Harley, left (north) on Gendy.

## Registration:

- North entrance of Will Rogers, off Lancaster Street (Near the Tower).  
Opens 1 hour before the first race of the day and closes 15 min prior to each event.  
All USCF riders MUST present their valid USCF license to the Registrar before signing in.  
Pre-registration on-line at [www.bikereg.com](http://www.bikereg.com).
- \$5 for late entry the day of the race.
- \$5 Discount for second and subsequent events.

## Other Information:

- Promoter reserves the right to combine fields and adjust prize list, if minimum field (10) is not met.  
Field limits of 100 racers. Men 5 and Women 4 limited to 50 riders each per USCF regulations.
- All USCF rules are in effect. Racers must wear a helmet that satisfies the standards specified in USA Cycling Policies, securely fastened at all times.
- Race held rain or shine, no refunds. There is an area to warm up adjacent to the course or bring a trainer.
