WURSTCROSS is the third weekend stop on the 2010 TXBRA Texas Cup Cyclocross Series and will be a South Regional Texas Cup event. The site of this race is Cypress Bend Park along the banks of the beautiful Guadalupe River in New Braunfels, Texas.

Non-USAC licensed Riders will be required to purchase a one-day USAC license (\$10.00). All participants must wear a certified helmet while on a bicycle. Bar ends must be removed from mountain bikes. All handle bars must be plugged. Promoter reserves the right to combine fields. Minimum cash purse for groups with cash prizes will be \$400 total.

Registration opens at 9:00AM race day and ends 15 minutes prior to each category start time. Pre-registration is available through: www.bikereg.com and online registration fees apply.

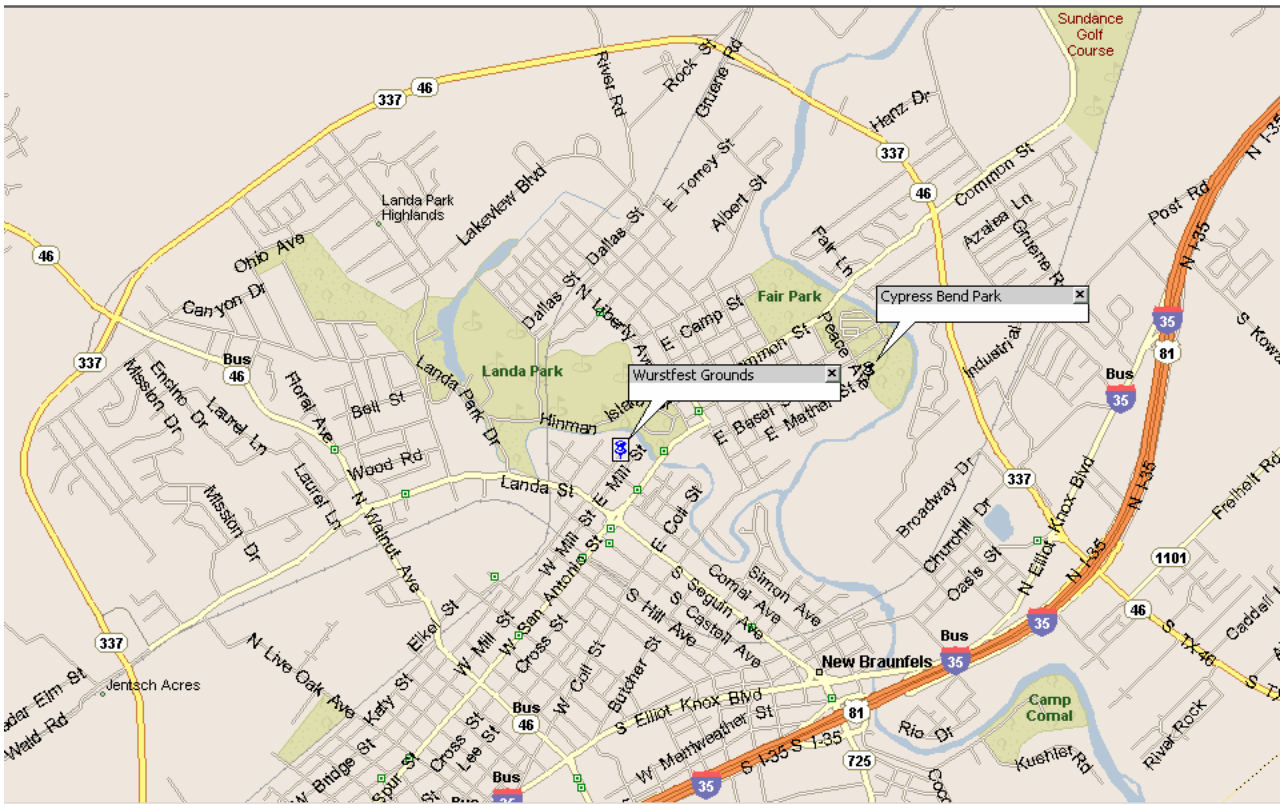
The Course: The 3km course will be laid out a bit differently than the 2007 edition. Terrain will include grass, dirt, pavement, hard pack, rock wall jump/runup and one set of wood barricades/traps (double).

DIRECTIONS:

From AUSTIN: Take I-35 South. Exit 189 (Hwy 46/Loop 337). Go West (right) on Hwy 46/Loop 337 and continue for 1.5 miles. Take a left on Common Street. Continue for ½ a mile and take a left on Peace Ave. Cypress Bend Park is 300 meters down on the left. Parking is available in the VFW Hall Parking area (adjacent to Cypress Bend Park) or along Peace Ave near the park entrance. FOR SAFETY OF YOUR FELLOW RACERS – Please do not pull into the park.

From SAN ANTONIO: Take I-35 North. Exit 189 (Hwy 46/Loop 337). Go West (left) on Hwy 46/Loop 337 and continue for 1.5 miles. Take a left on Common Street. Continue for ½ a mile and take a left on Peace Ave. Cypress Bend Park is 300 meters down on the left. Parking is available in the VFW Hall Parking area (adjacent to Cypress Bend Park) or along Peace Ave near the park entrance. FOR SAFETY OF YOUR FELLOW RACERS – Please do not pull into the park.

From HOUSTON: Take I-10 to Seguin. Hwy 46 to New Braunfels. When you get to the traffic light at Hwy 46 and I-35 you'll continue straight (West) on Hwy 46/Loop 337 and continue for 1.5 miles. Take a left on Common Street. Continue for ½ a mile and take a left on Peace Ave. Cypress Bend Park is 300 meters down on the left. Parking is available in the VFW Hall Parking area (adjacent to Cypress Bend Park) or along Peace Ave near the park entrance. FOR SAFETY OF YOUR FELLOW RACERS – Please do not pull into the park.
