This is a collegiate parking lot crit thrown together two weeks before the race to accompany the collegiate TT and RR that weekend so there will be a three-race collegiate weekend in DFW. Since this is collegiate and there is no money in collegiate no category's prize list will exceed \$1,999. Proceeds, if any which is seriously not likely to happen, will benefit the *SMU Cycling club*. Held rain or shine... no refunds.

All USAC Rules apply (and all SCCC rules too) – all racers must have a certified cycling helmet on their head when on their bike. All racers under 18 MUST have a signed parental permission slip (available on site or at http://www.usacycling.org/forms/waiver.php?url=rider_release.pdf) to race – NO EXCEPTIONS. All juniors (18 & under) must also be able to pass junior roll out.

USAC Collegiate Licenses required. One-day licenses will be sold on-site for applicable categories.

Registration and number pick-up begins 10:30am the day of the event in the parking lot of the Aubrey High school and ends 15 minutes prior to each race. Promoter reserves the right to adjust start times and race length.

Promoter reserves the right to combine or cancel events with less than 20 registered riders. USA Cycling Permit Applied for.

Directions: Aubrey High School: 510 Spring Hill Road Aubrey, TX 76227-3989. From the TT start/finish take a right out of the TT parking lot to head East on 428. Take a right onto S. Main Street to head South and follow this street as it turn to the left going east again and crossing some railroad tracks. Go straight passing the light at Hwy 377 and the H.S. will be after the light on your right.

Places to eat are located along Hwy 377 just north and south of the high school.

If you ride your bike between the TT and Crit locations you MUST follow all laws and stay far to the right. The police have ticketed race participants in the past for being in the lanes of traffic so be courteous and polite, PLEASE.
